ARTICLE-I ORGANISATION

SECTION-I

NAME:

SPINTRONIC TECHNOLOGY AND ADVANCE RESEARCH Alumni Society hereafter isreferred as 'STARAS' or the 'Society'.

Section II.

Purpose of the Society

The purposes of the Society / Association shall be to provide a vibrant forum that promotes interaction and networking among alumni of the Institute, Specially these shall be:

- 1. To help alumni achieve their professional and societal goals
- 2. To help alumni in their hour of need
- 3. To facilitate the association of alumni with their Alma Mater
- 4. To contribute to the Institute's vision of being recognized among the world's leading institutions in academics, research, outreach, and innovation
- To function on charitable basis, and to run the Association on 'no profit no loss' basis
- 6. To promote best practices in different areas of science, technology, humanities and social sciences for the benefit of the society, especially weaker sections.
- 7. To create awareness about the Institute and its alumni in the public
- 8. The association will act as a charitable organization and carry out socio economic development projects for development of the weaker section of the society. The association will also promote scientific & technical research and fund for such activities among the students of the institute from time to time.
- 9. The association can receive and maintain the books of accounts of donations, grants & aids from Government, PSUs, Members and any such organization wanted to contribute for the larger interest of the society and association by and large.
- 10. To assist deserving students from the sections of the society financially and otherwise

- 11. The association will also support its meritorious students of the institute to participate and attend international conferences and seminars on technology transformation areas.
- 12. . To hold annual meetings and ordinary meetings and discuss as follows:
 - a. Development of Association/ Society 's activities
 - b. Interesting topics relating to Science and Technology
 - c. Popular and motivational and Entrepreneur development.
- 13. To establish Research & Development, Entrepreneurship, Start up, Placement cell for the development of the carrier of the Ex-students.
- 14. Setting up carrier development Institutions for ongoing student's & Alumni's.

RULES AND REGULATION:

RULES AND REGULATIONS (BYE-LAWS) OF Spintronic Technology &Advance Research - Bhubaneswar Alumni Society

Section I

- a. Definition: The Society shall be called Spintronic Technology
 &Advance Research Bhubaneswar Alumni Society.
- b. Location: The registered Office of the Society shall be located at: Spintronic Technology &Advance Research Bhubaneswar Alumni Society, Star valley At -Taraboi, Jatani Bhubaneswar.
- c. Establishment: The Society: Spintronic Technology &Advance
 Research Bhubaneswar Alumni Association has been established as
 per Societies Registration Act, 1860. It is a non-political and nonprofiteering social organisation.
- d. Territory: The territory in which the Spintronic Technology &Advance Research Bhubaneswar Alumni Society's operations are to be conducted shall primarily be the territory of the Republic of India. In order to promote international brotherhood among its members and to ensure the fulfilment of its objectives covering professionals spread over the global village, the Spintronic Technology &Advance Research Bhubaneswar Alumni Society may extend its activities beyond the Territory of India.

Section II

Definitions

In these by-laws unless the context otherwise requires:

- "Society means the "Spintronic Technology &Advance Research -Bhubaneswar Alumni Society" (STARAS) registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860. • "Governing Body" means the "Spintronic Technology &Advance Research - Bhubaneswar Alumni Society" (STARAS), registered under the Societies Registration Act.
- 2. "General Body" means the Body consisting of all the members of the "Spintronic Technology &Advance Research Bhubaneswar Alumni Society" (STARAS).
- 3. "Advisory Committee" means the committee which may be formed to advise the Governing Body.
- 4. Sub-Committee means the committees formed from among the members of the Association to discharge certain allocation of work headed by one of the Governing Body Member/s of the Governing Body.
- 5. "Office" means a portion of the building within the "STAR campus" complex allotted to the Association by the Director / Registrar of STAR-Bhubaneswar for the purpose of office of the Society.
- 6. He & His include and mean both genders, singular or plural.
- 7. "Common expenses" means:
 - i) All sums lawfully assessed against the members by the Association
 - ii) Expenses agreed upon as common expenses by the General Body
- iii) Expenses declared as common expenses by the provisions of this Act or by the declaration or by the By-Laws of the Association. All expression used but not defined herein shall have the same meaning as assigned to them in the Act.

Section III

Aims and objectives of the Association

- a) To bring together the graduates and post-graduates students of STAR-Bhubaneswar and to promote fellow feeling among them.
- b) To foster a sense of community, co-ordination and links amongst the members inter se and between the members and other such organised bodies at colleges and universities.
- c) To support and assist the alumni with regard to placement and career developments, provide useful guidance for future career build up by keeping contact with government and Institute's authorities and other NGOs and corporate bodies.

- d) To coordinate with the government, universities, reputed institutes and other organisations in developing sound policies for the progress of technology and allied professions.
- e) To coordinate with similar other associations in India and abroad having common objectives.
- f) To encourage co-curricular, extra-curricular and socio-cultural activities between the members of the Association.

Section-IV

Powers of the Association:

To achieve these objectives the Association shall have the following power amongst others:

- a) To enter into any arrangement or agreement with Government Authorities, Colleges, Universities or any authority and organization that may seem conducive to the Association's objectives or any of them and to obtain from any such authority rights, privileges, concessions and aids, the Association may think desirable to obtain, and to carry out, exercise and comply with such arrangement, agreement, rights, privileges and concessions in the interest of the Association.
- b) To accept any request, gift, donation or subscription towards or to accumulate and provide a fund or an endowment and to invest the same and apply the income arising there from or to the purchase thereof for any of the objectives of the Association.
- c) To sell, improve, manage, develop, exchange, lease or let under lease or sub-let, mortgage, dispose of or otherwise to deal with all or any part of the property of the Association.
- d) To engage the services of persons or to appoint any person in employment, fix the remuneration thereof and to terminate their services for the purpose of the Association.
- e) To prepare a list of valid voters and to calculate the numbers of voters for or against any decision and declare the same in the General Body meeting.
- f) To determine, assess and receive the monthly contribution towards common expenses payable by the members.
- g) To open, operate and close accounts in any Schedules Bank.
- h) To invest the money and property of the Association not required immediately for the purpose of the Association in such securities or in such manners as may from time to time be determined.

- i) To raise funds for the Association as provided for in the Act and Rules.
- j) To provide for and do any other thing for the administration of the property.
- k) To pay subscription/donation to other organization in the interest of the Association. Governing Body Member:
